Spring & Summer Maintenance

We know that completing these tasks can feel more dutiful than joyful. But regular maintenance is the key to preserving your home's value and keeping everything up-to-date is the best way to save yourself from costly repairs down the line.

SPRING

- Replace furnace filters
- Clean the garbage disposal by grinding ice cubes, then flushing with hot water and baking soda
- Clean the kitchen exhaust fan filter
- Clean tub and sink drains with vinegar and banking soda; unclog if necessary
- Run water and flush toilets in unused spaces
- Check the water softener; add salt if needed
- Clean the dryer vent
- Give your house a deep clean
- Vacuum your refrigerator coils
- Inspect the exterior of your home, including drainage
- Remove leaves and debris from gutters, downspouts, and window wells
- Have the air-conditioner professionally serviced
- Clean window and door screens; repair/replace damaged window screens
- Clear dead plants and shrubs
- Inspect roofing for damage, leaks, etc.
- Fertilize and aerate your lawn
- Activate and check your sprinkler system
- Clean and repair the deck/patio as needed
- Have your water heater serviced

SUMMER

- Replace furnace filters
- Clean tub and sink drains with vinegar and baking soda; unclog if necessary
- Vacuum heat registers and vents
- Run water and flush toilets in unused spaces
- Give your house a deep clean
- Check the grout in bathrooms, kitchen, and tiles; repair as needed
- Take care of any insect problems
- Refinish/seal the deck if needed
- Inspect plumbing for leaks; clean aerators on faucets
- Clean the dryer vent and other exhaust vents to the exterior of the home
- Clean the garage
- Oil the garage-door opener track, chain, and all door hinges
- Clean the kitchen exhaust fan filter
- Prune trees and shrubs
- Repair and paint exterior as needed
- Check the attic and crawl spaces for critters; call a pest specialist if needed
